Fees	
Application Fee	An application fee of \$150 is required for each student and is non-refundable. This fee is submitted with the student's application for enrollment.
Assessment Fee	An assessment fee of \$50 is required for each new student entering Kindergarten and above. The assessment will determine if the student is a candidate for Cornerstone Academy. The fee is submitted to the office on the day of the assessment.
Supply Fee	The supply fee, as listed above, is required for each student, and is nonrefundable after the first day of school. The fee for the 1 st child is due on June 1 st . The supply fee for additional children may be paid June 1 st OR rolled into the total tuition balance and paid through FACTS by monthly payments.
Building Fee	Each family is required to pay a building fee to help with maintainance of the faciliy. Beginning school fee is \$150, Grammar is \$500 per family. Fees are determined by the oldest child enrolled. Due June 1 st .
CAPT Fee	Each family is required to pay a one time \$30 contribution to the parent group, CAPT. Due June 1 st .
Sibling Discount	Tuition discounts are listed above for families with more than one child enrolled at Cornerstone Academy. The oldest child pays full tuition as the 1 st child. If a family has more than 4 children, the additional children are free.
Pre-Payment Discount	A 2% discount is offered on tuition only, provided that all tuition and fees (application, assessment & supply) are paid in full by July 1 st .

Class Descriptions

Preschool

M/W/F or T/Th or M-F **9-11:45am** **8:00-4:00** (Full Day)

This class is for children who are three years old by September 1. Learning centers around five themes that evoke curiosity to explore learning. Children get to create, chant, memorize bible verses and begin the foundational skills of phonics and number sense. Students who attend Cornerstone's preschool learn 20 bible verses, all the sounds for each letter, and have the opportunity to begin writing and doing simple math. Extended day kids get to have lunch and recess then an enrichment class such as music, dramatic play, science and more!

PreKindergarten

M/W/F or T/Th or M-F **9-11:45am** **8:00-4:00** (Full Day)

Four year olds will love being in our active learning PreK class. Students are challenged with mastering letters, shapes, colors as well as letter sounds and pre-reading skills. Students are immersed in phonics and language learning centers as well as math manipulative stations. Students attend a field trip once per unit. Extended day kids get to have lunch and recess, then an enrichment class such as music, dramatic play, science and more!

Kindergarten

Mon - Fri **8:15-11:45** (Half Day) **8:15-3:30** (Full Day)

Students go around the world to learn about all of the amazing continents. They do this by reading, writing, singing, drawing and creating while experiencing each integrated theme. By the end of Kindergarten, students will be able to write and present a report on one continent, along with reciting 26 A to Z bible verses. Because Cornerstone believes strongly in making learning interesting and engaging, the cost of 10 thematically integrated field trips is included as part of the Kindergarten adventure!

1st-8th Grades Signature Classes

Mon - Fri **8:15-3:30**

Students are engaged in a chronologically integrated study through history. They learn through songs, chants and memorization of relevant facts in every subject including grammar, spelling, world language, history and science. Students are grouped by ability for reading, spelling and math. At the conclusion of the year, students will create a Capstone Project highlighting their learning during the year. Included in tuition are 10 thematically integrated field trips. Students will also participate in events like Spelling Bee, Science Fair, Capstone Projects, and musical productions.

1st-8th Grades Selections Classes

Tues/Thurs **8:15-3:30**

Families who would like to have a high caliber classical christian education in both a home learning and classroom learning will enjoy our university model program. Over the course of both Tuesday and Thursday, students will have all core learning covered in addition to some enrichment classes.

K-12 Independent Study Program

Schedule is individualized

Our new Independent Study Program has opened due to community interest and our desire to see classical education provided for all families. This program is designed for homeschooling families who desire to have their child receive a diploma through an accredited school. Our advisors are prepared to partner with parents in setting academic goals and locating resources that lead to a mature graduate ready to engage the next phase of life with confidence and wisdom. Parents may select to have the advisor meet as often as desired, as often as once a week or as few as once a quarter.

Class Descriptions

2 Day T/Th 8:15-3:30
 Families who would like to have a high caliber classical christian education in both a home learning and traditional classroom learning will enjoy our 2 day program. Students will receive instruction in all core subjects and enjoy some enrichment classes as well.

FAQ's

Do I have to stay on campus with my child?

No, you may drop off and pick up since we are an accredited school. We would love for families to volunteer around the school and in classrooms though.

Do I have to register as a homeschooling family?

Yes, you are still considered a homeschooling family. You are accountable to the teacher for completion of the coursework.

Who grades my child's work?

Parents and teachers will share the grading based on how many days your child is present. Final grades are recorded in our online grading system and report cards are created for every student.

Will my child have an annual standardized test?

Yes, included in your tuition is the CTP4 assessment each Spring. It is normed to national averages as well as other classically educated students.

Do the classes go on field trips?

Yes, included in your tuition are all field trips that your child's grade attends. Typically there is one field trip per month.

Will I need to buy books?

Novels and workbooks will be covered in your tuition and supply fees. We are working on how to provide teacher's manuals for subjects parents will be supporting at home.

Can my child attend other classes?

Yes! If you would like to have your child attend any electives or specialist classes, we charge \$90 per trimester per child .
